ELEMENTS OF A SETTLEMENT

1. Palestine/Eretz Israel west of the Jordan River are a common homeland of both the Palestinian and Jewish peoples. Both peoples have the right to exercise self-determination in this area within recognized and final borders.
2. Israelis recognize that the Palestinians are a people entitled to political expression of their national identity in a state.
3. The Palestinian people recognize the right of Israel to exist as Israel recognizes the right of the Palestinian people to their own state.
4. The settlement of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict will be final.
5. Both sides will end acts of violence against each other.
6. The Palestinian people alone determine who their leaders are to be.
7. The Palestinian state will be composed of the West Bank and Gaza Strip which will have free passage between both regions.
8. There will be a confederation of the Palestinian state and Jordan as equal partners.
9. The Palestinian state will be demilitarized and neither Israel nor the confederation will join military alliances aimed at the other.

10. The Palestinian right of return and the resolution of the refugee problem will be confined to the Palestinian state or the Palestinian-Jordanian confederation.
11. Israeli citizens who elect to remain in the Palestinian state will have equal civil rights.
12. There will be no new Israeli settlements and no expansion of existing settlements in the West Bank and Gaza.
13. The status of Jerusalem will be resolved in a mutually acceptable arrangement.
14. There will be a Joint Consultative Committee to consider any issues arising under the agreement.
15. No inciting (provocative) propaganda campaign will be waged by either side.
16. Common ventures, including the water regime, will be mutually agreed.
17. A shrine will be built jointly in Jerusalem for the victims of both sides in the Arab-Israeli conflict.

Addendum

The settlement and resolution of all disputes arising under the settlement will be achieved only by negotiation among authorized representatives of the parties--not by violence. In order to create a positive environment for negotiation, all parties will agree not to condone violence in any form.
