

Some Comments On The Clements' Document

Art. ① : - Replace "Jewish" by "Israeli". Another sentence may be added to ensure that diaspora Jews have a special relationship with this homeland.

✓ - Precede the word "recognized" by the word "internationally".

Art. ② : - Precede "political expression" by "sovereign"
- follow the last word in the sentence, i.e. "state", by the expression "in this homeland".

Art. ③ : - On the basis of the principle of mutuality, and given the wording in Art. ②, this has to be read ~~as~~ to say that Palestinians recognize that the Israelis are a people entitled to etc. etc. Ent of ~~sa para~~ tautologous.

Art. ④ : Add: "This includes the Iron-Fist Policy carried out by the occupation authorities".

Art. ⑤ ~~Need~~ To be read
- "Negotiations to enact the terms of this agreement must be held by the PLO in its capacity as the party which represents the Palestinian people, and the Israeli Government."
- In any case, delete the words "to be" at its end.

Art. ⑦ - The Palestinian State will be set up within internationally recognized boundaries, and in particular on the ^{Palestinian} territories occupied by Israel in the 1967 war, with ~~as~~ a guarantee of free alien of movement between the regions of Gaza and the West Bank.

Art. (8);

To be read as follows:

"The future relations between the independent Palestinian State which is to be established and Jordan will be those of confederation".

Art. (9);

To be read as follows:

"The safety and security of the Palestinian state will be guaranteed by an international arrangement involving the Super Powers. Within this context the Palestinian state will be demilitarized to the extent necessary to safeguard the security of Israel."

Art. (10)

To be read as follows (or to mean):

"The problem of the refugees has to be settled in the context of UN resolutions pertaining to the matter, and in accordance with mutually acceptable arrangements."

Art. (11)

Add the following to the end of the sentence

"in accordance with the ^{new} laws of the state"

Art. (13)

Add the following to the end of the sentence:

"on the basis of (a) shared sovereignty, (b) continued unification and (c) a one city / two capitals status."
